



Archery Range Rules

No Parking in front of any gates, cables, or on any access roads.

No Stump or random shooting.

Always be aware of your target and what is beyond it.

No Broadhead tipped arrows are to be used on LVSA Targets.

If you wish to shoot broadheads, you may bring your own target as long as it will prevent any arrow or bolt from passing completely through it.

Paper targets, foam targets, balloons, bag targets, and other targets that do not leave debris may be used.

All shooters must use a common firing line and keep their equipment pointed in a safe direction at all times.

Coordinate arrow retrieval with your fellow members if there is more than one member using the range.

No Littering. Please use the trash receptacles.

Any person under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult member.

One guest is permitted to accompany a member.

If you use the picnic tables on the practice range, please move them away from the firing line when you are done with them.

Archery facilities are for the use of members displaying a current card. All other will be considered trespassers and asked to leave.
