

RULES FOR USE OF PISTOL RANGE

1. Paper targets or balloons only, NO CANS OR BOTTLES. NO STEEL TARGETS ON THIS RANGE.
2. Range is for members only.
3. A member may bring one guest.
4. Any member has preference over a guest. A guest has to yield the use of a bench to a member.
5. A membership card is the only proof of membership, you may be asked to produce your membership card. If you do not have your card, ANY MEMBER CAN ASK YOU TO LEAVE.
6. Any member or their guest using the range in an unsafe or unsportsmanlike manner may be subject to having their membership revoked. Firing at the safety baffles is prohibited.
7. Place targets on back boards away from metal frames in such a manner that the bullets do not hit the supports. Please return the 24"x30" cardboard backstops to the storage container when finished with the range.
8. All shooters will use one of the 12 positions at the common firing line. Metal frames can be moved to fit your shooting needs.
9. Only 1 frame is to be used in each designated shooting lane. Firing across shooting lanes is prohibited.
10. Shooting hours are 8:00 am to dusk.
11. Remove your targets, clean up your spent brass, put all unwanted brass in the brass buckets and all trash in trash containers when you are finished shooting.
12. The range is closed the first day of rifle deer season, and during any club function. See our web site calendar for the current range closings.
13. No firing of any fully automatic weapons on the range.
14. Anyone under eighteen (18) years of age MUST be accompanied by an adult.
16. No pistols exceeding .45 Caliber Magnum or pistols chambered with rifle calibers are allowed. You may use the rifle range for these firearms.
17. ALL PERSONS AT THIS RANGE MUST WEAR EAR PROTECTION.
18. ALL UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING THIS RANGE ARE CONSIDERED TO BE TRESPASSING.
19. There are (2) steel frames at the rifle range for members that have conditions that prevent them from accessing the pistol range easily.
